Here is an update directly from Sun Valley, a privately

owned resort, President & General Manager, Tim Silva.

"All of us here at the Sun Valley Resort are looking forward to the upcoming winter. Weather dependent, our plan is to open Bald Mountain on Thanksgiving & Dollar Mountain on Dec. 12th. We are fortunate to be somewhat off the beaten path, and to have significant slope and lift capacities contributing to a relatively uncrowded resort. We have also been busy this summer completing a 380 acre expansion of skiable terrain on Bald Mountain and replacing the old Cold Springs lift with a state of the art express guad lift. We do not plan to implement a reservation system or visitation limits for Sun Valley Season Pass holders or Epic Pass holders on Bald Mountain or Dollar Mountain this 20/21 winter season. If necessary, we will manage peak day access for both Bald Mountain and Dollar Mountain through day-ticket restrictions."

The BAC Skiers will not need to make a reservation since we have FWSA Group Lift tickets or EPIC Passes. I will feature some of the Tahoe resorts in my December Newsletter.
